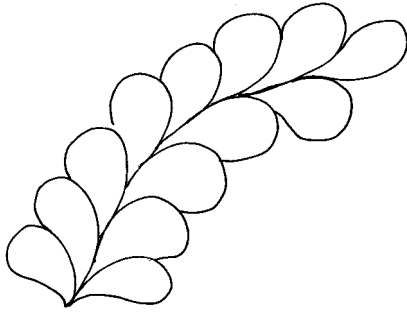


Totally Free Motion Quilting

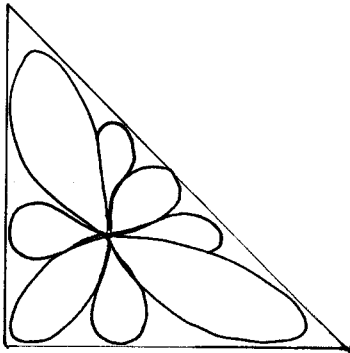


One Day Workshop: For the experienced machine quilter who is ready for a challenge. We will explore scads of free motion designs that don't require marking the quilt, including feathered wreaths and border garlands. We will discuss specialty threads and bobbin quilting. Intermediate to advanced skill level. (Stubborn beginners are always welcome.)

Supply List

Before class:

Please layer and pin baste four 18-inch square quilt sandwiches. Please use cotton fabric and batting. Keep the fabrics tone on tone or solids so that we can see our stitches. Please avoid multicolor prints. Don't use any fabric that you are emotionally attached to.



Notions:

Sewing machine in good working order with a darning (free motion) foot. Please make sure that you have the correct foot for your machine and that you know how to attach it. Bring the manual!

Bobbins wound with good quality cotton thread, contrasting to backing fabric.

Sewing machine needles: Schmetz Microtex Sharps, size 80/12 and/or 70/10.

Schmetz Topstitching needles, size 90/14

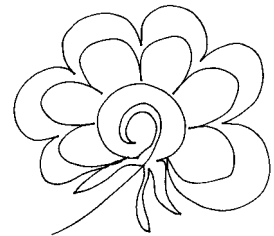
Threads:

Good Quality 100% cotton thread that **contrasts** with your fabric.

Rayon thread, any color that contrasts will do.

Metallic thread

Bring paper and pencil to practice the designs.



Not required but strongly suggested:

Quilt So Easy Discs from Heavenly Notions

Absolutely required: your inner child, preferably age nine, and a wicked sense of humor.
